INSTRUCTIONS OF USE

- BY HAND: Vacuum the surface before using the product. Spread the foam with a soft brush on areas of approx. 2 sq. mt. Let it dry for some minutes and vacuum again.
- WITH FLOOR POLISHING MACHINE: Vacuum the surface before using the product. Spread the foam and buff with an extra-soft brush on areas of approx. 2 sq. mt. Let it dry for some minutes and vacuum again.

FIRST AID MEASURES

Description of first aid measures:
